Criteria for admission as a Professional Member of the ITIA

- Interpreter* -

1) A postgraduate qualification in interpreting awarded by an Irish third-level institution or similar foreign institution recognised by the Irish Translators' and Interpreters' Association

Plus

A minimum of 2 years full-time work as an interpreter (or a correspondingly longer period part-time) with a minimum of 40 days or 280 hours interpreting per year

Plus

A PASS in the ITIA Professional Membership Examination

OR

2) A primary degree in translation/interpreting awarded by an Irish third-level institution or similar foreign institution recognised by the Irish Translators' and Interpreters' Association

Plus

A minimum of 3 years full-time work as an interpreter (or a correspondingly longer period part-time) with a minimum of 40 days or 280 hours interpreting per year

Plus

A PASS in the ITIA Professional Membership Examination

OR

3) A minimum of 5 years full-time interpreting work with a minimum of 40 days or 280 hours interpreting in each year, where the Professional Membership sub-committee is satisfied that there may be sufficient grounds for exemption with regard to qualifications.

Plus

A PASS in the ITIA Professional Membership Examination
